### MSC FINANCIAL AID DISBURSEMENT DATE:

Murray State College disbursement will be on MSC campus, February 14<sup>th</sup> in the Business Office and February 16<sup>th</sup>, 9:30a.m.-2:30p.m. in the AHEC Lobby, and 2:30-6:00 p.m. in the MSC suite. In order to pick up your financial aid refund check, you must have your attendance verification form signed by 2 instructors (total 6 credit hours) and have a photo ID. Now is the time to file the 2006-07 financial aid application, FAFSA. You will need your 2005 income totals. If you received a PIN number in the mail, please use this to sign your FAFSA on the web electronically. You can also file the renewal FAFSA on the web for 2006-07 using your PIN number. If you are planning to attend summer school and need financial aid, we will have the summer questionnaire available at the end of this month. You can pick one up in the MSC suite.
